

FZW 2010 Band Camp Information

Band Camp Rules and Policies:

- 1) All rules of the School District, and disciplinary consequences, will be enforced.
- 2) All policies outlined in the Silver Jaguar Band Handbook are in effect.
- 3) Students are expected to be at the entire camp, as scheduled
- 4) Alcohol, illicit drugs, tobacco and weapons of any kind are not allowed at camp
- 5) Respect for the facilities is essential.

Consequences (in addition to FZSD Disciplinary Guidelines):

- 1) first strike – warning
- 2) second strike – second warning, phone call home
- 3) third strike – You’re out! Student will be sent home. Student will no longer be allowed membership in FZWHS Band.

Certain actions may constitute an automatic third strike. Above all, remember that we are there to get to know each other in a positive atmosphere. We are there to learn our fundamentals and as much of our show as possible. We strive to be a superior band, and it begins with band camp!

Week 1, July 26 – 29

Monday, July 26 & Thursday, July 29 – 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM

Students will get a lunch break at 12:00 Noon.

Tuesday, July 27 & Wednesday, July 28 – 12 Noon – 8:00 PM

Students will get a dinner break at 4:30 PM.

They are responsible for their own meals during this week. If students leave campus for meals, they will not be excused for returning late.

____ YOUR OWN WATER BOTTLE – we are cutting down on the amount of disposable cups we use, and the amount of time we are taking for breaks. You should have your own water bottle (NO SHARING, due to “sharing” of germs/illnesses) and only use the water jugs to refill this bottle!

Week 2, August 1 – 6

Drop off students at Camp Cuivre, Cuivre River State Park at 5:00 PM. Students will check in and get their camp assignments. Students may drive themselves, but must turn in their keys when they check in. There will be dinner Sunday. Students will need to be picked up between 12:30 PM and 1:00 PM at Camp Cuivre, or if they ride the bus back to school, they should arrive between 1:30 PM and 2:00 PM. They will have the rest of the day off.

We will have our final day of camp at school on Friday, August 6, beginning at 7:00 AM. Students will have a pool party during the afternoon. We will conclude camp with a family barbeque and a preview of our 2010 field show, based on what we have accomplished during the two weeks of camp. The barbeque will begin at 5:30 PM, with the show at approximately 7:00 PM.

Students may bring a pack of soda, but it MUST BE KEPT in the kitchen. This is a State regulation. We may be fined if ANY food is discovered in cabins. The cabins do not have adequate storage for food and drink, and will attract wildlife!!!

We will have a registered nurse at camp this year. He will be responsible for all medical forms and medication at camp. Students will turn in medication to him, and he will keep track of the students taking it.

All students should have white t-shirts and tan shorts for the morning and evening rehearsals to help us with setting the drill. We will use this practice uniform for the entire season.

Finally, we will have competitions between sections or cabins to earn points towards a big prize at the end of camp. Cabin decorations, participation in theme days and other things will count towards those points. We will give details of this during the week of July 26 – 29.
